Sample Article: Gobster, P. H. (2004) "The human dimensions of urban greenways: Planning for recreation and related experiences." *Landscape and Urban Planning*, 68(2-3), 147-65.

- Method #1 – Open URL Link to the article – Use the *Article Locator* template to generate a link, at <http://www.library.uni.edu/find-specific-journal-or-known-article> and then proxy the link for off-campus access.
(This method provides a link to the Rod Library linker and not directly to the article)
- Method #2 – *Direct link* to the article – This is a 2 step process: You have to find the persistent (stable URL) and then you have to proxy the link for off-campus access.
(This method provides a direct link to the article)

Use the sample article listed above.

- Step #a – Locate the durable/persistent/stable article URL, e.g.,
<http://www.sciencedirect.com/science/article/pii/S0169204603001622>
- Step #b – Add the following text string (<https://login.proxy.lib.uni.edu/login?url=>) to the front of the persistent URL: e.g.,
<https://login.proxy.lib.uni.edu/login?url=http://www.sciencedirect.com/science/article/pii/S0169204603001622>

Link to eBooks

Use the *Specialized UNISTAR* search feature at, http://unistar.uni.edu/screens/rod_special.html to locate ebooks. The UNISTAR record link to the ebook is already proxified. Another method is to conduct a keyword UNISTAR search and type ebrary and a topic in the search box, e.g., ebrary and education. Click the book title to bring up the complete UNISTAR record. Next, right click on the *Connect to via ebrary* link located in the middle of the record. You will see the proxified link to the ebook. Next, select *Copy Link Location* and paste link in your eLearning module.
