

To focus your searches using OneSearch try the following commands:

*	farm*	finds articles with the word farm, farms, farming, farmer, etc.
OR	farming OR agriculture	finds articles that contain either of these words
AND	water AND climate	finds articles that contain both “water” and “climate”
“ ”	“water pollution”	finds the exact phrase

Another powerful technique is to search for your topic (keywords) in the title of articles. To do this change the dropdown menu in the AdvancedSearch from “Select a Field” to “TI Title”

Searching: **OneSearch!**

"water pollution"	TI Title
AND	Select a Field (optional)

AND	AU Author
	TI Title

For the following search example the phrase “climate change” must appear in the title of the article as must some version of farming or agriculture.

Be sure to limit the results to “Full Text” and “News” and set the “Publication Date” to recent years
