Serious Tools for Serious Searchers

Rod Library - Databases A-Z

• Family & Society Studies Worldwide

Subject headings include: child support --- law & legislation, child abuse --- law & legislation, child welfare, children --- health --- law & legislation, family violence, decision making – moral & ethical aspects, legislators – attitudes, legislation

• <u>PsycINFO</u>

Subject headings include: Government-Policy-Making, Policy-Making

Consider limiting "Methodology" (at the bottom of the page) to Empirical Study (research)

- <u>**PubMed</u>** (health and medicine consider Advanced Search))</u>
- <u>Social Services Abstracts</u>
- <u>Social Work Abstracts</u>
- <u>Sociological Abstracts</u>
- <u>Web of Knowledge</u> (for locating the most cited research)

... might also try:

Rod Library - Databases A-Z

- Academic OneFile (after you get your results limit to Academic Journals)
- Academic Search Elite (limit to "Scholarly")

Use Google Scholar to find Known Articles

To get the **Find it!** @ **UNI off campus when using** <u>Google Scholar</u> either use <u>Google Scholar</u> from the Rod Library page or set your computer as follows:

- 1. choose "Scholar Preferences"
- 2. type "Northern Iowa" in the "Library Links" blank and click on "Find Library"
- 3. put check in box next to "University of Northern Iowa
- 4. click on "Save Preferences" button (top of page)

<u>Search Tricks</u> (WARNING – these don't work with Google or Google Scholar)

Put an asterisk - * - at the end of the root of a word to find all versions: e.g. abus* abuse, abused, abusive, abuses, abusers, abusing,

(warning ... LexisNexis uses the exclamation symbol ! instead of the asterisk)

Combine separate concepts with "and"

e.g. homeless* and Iowa

Combine similar concepts (synonyms) with "or" and parentheses e.g. child* and (neglect* or abus* or abandon*) and legislat*
